ABOUT THE COURSE

The online course on 'BftW Standards and Compliances (E-Capsule)' is designed specifically to deal with BftW grant conditions and its reporting requirements. Ensuring fulfilment of BftW standards and reporting requirements is one of the primary responsibilities of the partner organizations.

The course addresses certain important aspects such as finalizing project proposals, budget preparation, selection of project auditors, preparing fund requests & acknowledgment of remittances, preparation of financial & progress reports, and so on.

This course will not only help the participants to learn comprehensively about various requirements, but will also help in understanding the relevance and importance of it.



OBJECTIVE

By the end of the course,

- The participants will have a thorough understanding and knowledge of the various BftW standards and compliance requirements.
- The participants will be able to comply and fulfill all the necessary compliance requirements of BftW.
- The participants will be able to prepare a good quality budget, fund request, financial statements etc.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

Senior and finance staff members from existing as well as new partner organizations should attend this course.

DURATION

The duration of the course is 12 weeks. This course is conceptualized on a rolling batch model.

COMPOSITION OF THE COURSE

There are a total 5 modules divided into 30 Chapters that would be covered during the course.

1. Fundamentals of BftW Grants
2. Pre-approval & Implementation Stages of BftW Grants
3. Operational Aspects of BftW Grants
4. Critical Aspects of BftW Grants
5. Project Closure and Completion of BftW Grants

LEARNING METHODOLOGY

FMSF has developed an interactive online learning platform and it will provide a unique learning experience. The combination of various learning tools makes the experience enjoyable to the participants.

At the end of each module, an interactive session will be conducted over Zoom, Questions/Self-Assessment Tests, and Case Studies, etc. to understand and accelerate the learning of the participants.
